

CyberWhiz Cookie Notice

As CyberWhiz LTD (“CyberWhiz” or “the Company”), we utilize certain technologies such as cookies, pixels, GIFs, etc. (“cookies”) to enhance your experience during your use or visit to our websites (“Site”), applications, or any similar online or offline channels we offer in the digital environment (all referred to collectively as the “Platform”).

The use of these technologies is carried out in compliance with the legislation to which we are subject, primarily the Personal Data Protection Law No. 6698 (“PDPL”).

The purpose of this Cookie Clarification Text is to inform you about the processing of personal data obtained through the collection of personal data such as cookies and pixels used during the use of the Platforms. In this text, we want to explain to you which types of cookies we use for what purposes on the Platform and how you can control these cookies. As the Company, we reserve the right to discontinue using the cookies we use on our site and application, to change their types or functions, or to add new cookies to our site and application.

Therefore, we reserve the right to change the provisions of this Cookie Clarification Text at any time. Any changes made to the current Cookie Clarification Text will come into effect upon being published on the site, in the application, or any publicly accessible platform. You can find the date of the last update at the end of the text.

Purposes and Legal Bases for Processing Your Personal Information

Your personal data collected will be processed within the scope of the personal data processing conditions and purposes specified in Article 5 of the Law on the Protection of Personal Data (“KVKK”) for the purposes stated below (“Purposes”). Cookies are used on the platform for different purposes. Depending on the type of cookie used, the purposes of data processing and the condition of data processing we rely on within the scope of the KVKK may vary.

Essential Cookies Related to Mandatory Identification Information

Essential cookies are those placed on your device while you view the Platform and are necessary for the proper functioning of the online services provided. The processing activities of the mandatory identification information we carry out during the use of these cookies are based on the condition of data processing in Article 5 of the KVKK, which states “processing of personal data belonging to the parties of a contract is necessary, provided that it is directly related to the establishment or performance of the contract.”

Functional Cookies Related to Functionality Identification Information

Functionality cookies are cookies that are necessary for the provision of certain functions on the Platform and for remembering your preferences related to these functions. For example, functionality cookies are used to remember your language preference on the platform or to save your settings regarding cookie usage.

The processing activities of the functional identification information we carry out during the use of these cookies are based on the condition of data processing in Article 5 of the KVKK as “your explicit consent.”

Performance Cookies

We don't use any performance cookie except Google Analytics which is described under Third Party Cookies.

Third Party Cookies

All of the cookies described so far in this cookie notice are “first party cookies”, which means they are set and controlled by us. Occasionally, third parties may set cookies on our Sites which we do not control. These are called “third party cookies”. This will happen where, for example, we have included embedded content on some pages of our Sites. When you visit a page with embedded content, the third-party service provider may set its own cookies on your web browser.

This also applies if you choose to connect with our social media accounts by clicking on one of the social media buttons on our Sites, as you may be sent cookies by these websites.

Please note that we do not control these cookies and cannot access them. Cookies can only be accessed by the party who originally set them. You should therefore check the third-party websites for more information about these cookies. We have listed some of these providers below and included a link to their privacy policies (this is exemplary list – see cookies banner to check list of cookies that we actually use):

- **Google Analytics:** We use Google Analytics for statistical analysis. How We Collect Personal Information

Your personal data is collected electronically through cookies during your visit to our website.

To Whom Personal Information May Be Transferred and For What Purpose

As CyberWhiz, within the scope of the Cookie Clarification Text, we may share your personal data, limited to the purposes stated above and in compliance with the legislation, with our suppliers, our business partners whose details you can see in the cookie preference management area, and legally authorized public institutions and private individuals.

How Can I Control the Use of Cookies?

The preferences of our visitors and users regarding the use of cookies and similar technologies are fundamental for us. Below is the information on how you can manage your preferences for the cookies used on the Platform:

Visitors have the opportunity to personalize their preferences for cookies by changing the browser settings they use to view the Platform. If the browser being used offers this possibility, it is possible to change the preferences for cookies through the browser settings. Thus, depending on the capabilities offered by the browser, data owners may have the option to block the use of cookies, prefer to receive a warning before cookies are used, or disable or delete only certain cookies.

Your Rights

As a data subject, we would like to inform you that you have the following rights under Article 11 of the Law:

1. To learn whether your personal data is being processed,
2. To request information if your personal data has been processed,
3. To understand the purpose of data processing and whether this data is used for intended purposes,
4. To know the third parties to whom personal data is transferred domestically or abroad,
5. To request the correction of personal data if it is processed incompletely or inaccurately and to request that the process carried out in this context be notified to the third parties to whom the personal data has been transferred,
6. To request the deletion or destruction of personal data in the event that the reasons necessitating its processing cease to exist, despite being processed in accordance with the provisions of the Law and other relevant laws, and to request that the process carried out in this context be notified to the third parties to whom the personal data has been transferred,
7. To object to the emergence of a result against the person himself/herself through the analysis of the processed data exclusively by automated systems,
8. To request compensation for the damages in case of loss due to unlawful processing of personal data.
